between sessions 3 and 4 in April. We will be adding assemblies, fieldtrips, or performances during the

***Central Station* Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by Ms. Chastity Sessions 3 & 4 *Grades K-5*

This program offers an opportunity for fun enrichment activities including crafts, legos, beading, cooking, technology, games, and more! Every day is a new adventure!

***Arts and Crafts* Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by Ms. Jennifer Sessions 3 & 4 *Grades K-5*

Fun crafts and art projects await you. Show us your creative side using a wide variety of resources including wood, paper, fabrics, yarn, paints, crayons, and more!

***In the Zone* Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by Mrs. Vang Sessions 3 & 4 *Grades K-5*

This is a time set aside where you will be able to use your artistic talents on special Creative Coloring projects! **OR** work on homework if needed, classroom teachers are available for homework consultation if requested.

***Lego Land* Mondays**

Led by: Ms. Hofmann Session 3 & 4 *Grades 1-5*

Legos, legos, and more legos! See what you can create with your imagination - combine yours with others to make an object for discussion. How skilled are you at building blindfolded? Whether making patterns or racing against others, come and join us and see where your imagination takes you.

***Nail Art Club* Mondays**

Led by Ms. Kirstin McEvoy Session 3 & 4 ***Grades 2-5***

Nail art is a fun and creative way to paint, decorate, and embellish the nails. Join us to enjoy and explore the latest nail art craze! Students will create art on their own nails as well as work with others in the class.

***Games Galore* Mondays**

Led by: Ms. Smith Sessions 3 & 4 ***Grades K-1***

Join us as we will play and learn a wide variety of games both indoors and outdoors (weather permitting). From playing cards, to board games to physically active games, you will be sure to have a blast with this class!

***Swim Lessons* Mondays and Tuesdays**

Led By: Mr. Woosencraft, Mrs. Kramer, Mrs. Veenstra Session 3 & 4 ***Grades 2-5***

(Limit of 32 students-4 groups of 8)

A new program!!! We will be partnering with UW-Marathon County Campus for use of their pool, and the YMCA to offer swim lessons to Lincoln students. With a focus on water safety and skill development, the YMCA instructors and lifeguards will provide lessons and support to help students learn to swim as well as water safety. NOTE: This class is SWIM LESSONS not free play in the pool. All abilities are welcome! Students will be tested and grouped according to abilities at the first class. Students will walk or be bused to and from the UW-MC pool which is about 1 block from Lincoln, chaperoned by male and female Lincoln staff both in the locker areas and pool. Students may be asked to wear a swim cap provided as part of this class.

Students must follow these Aquatic Policies:

Swim Attire: Proper swim suits need to be worn in the swimming pool. (If assistance is needed with this please contact Mrs. Dreikosen) Street clothing may not be used as a swim suit. ***Each student will need their own towel.***

Street Shoes: To maintain cleanliness of the deck facilities and to follow the WI Dept. of Health and Family Services codes; we cannot allow street shoes on the pool decks. Shoes not worn on the street is an acceptable alternative.

Electronic Devices: No electronic devices in locker rooms. No telephone conversations in program areas.

Horseplay: Inappropriate behavior in the locker rooms or pool area will not be tolerated and may lead to immediate dismissal from the class if deemed necessary.

***Kiddin Around Yoga!* Tuesdays (limit of 15)**

Led by: Ms. Jessie Robinson Session 3 & 4 ***Grades 1-5***

This is a great way for kids to unwind after a long day in school. Students will practice silly asana sequences, play fun and challenging yoga style games as well as learn self-calming and stress relief techniques to develop strong minds and bodies.

***Kid Power* Tuesdays (Limited to 20 students)**

Led by: Ms. Pergolski Session 4 ***Grades 4/5***

Fun! Fitness! Technology! UNICEF Kid Power is a program aimed at increasing U.S. children's activity levels by tapping into children's intrinsic desire to do good. Students will wear activity bands provided by the program that are synced to a computer program. Through their activity levels, kids earn points, which unlocks funding from partners of UNICEF that will support treatment for a malnourished child.

***SnapShot Science* Tuesdays**

Led by: Mr. Schmidt ***Grades 3-5*** Session 3/***Grades 1-2*** Session 4

Each meeting will feature an important science 'snapshot,' a specific topic or concept which students will explore. Inquiry-based investigations will develop students' natural curiosity and ability to think scientifically, as well as practice science skills such as careful observation, measurement, and use of scientific equipment.

***Superkids* Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by: Ms. Smith Session 3 & 4 ***Grade 1***

Join Cass, Hot Rod, Lily and all the other Superkids characters as we support and expand upon the Superkids Reading Program with hands on projects and fun review activities. **New students are welcome, students from Session 1 and 2 will continue.**

***Self Defense* Thursdays**

Led by Ms. Sylvia Thao Sessions 3 & 4 ***Grade K-5 at some point during Sessions 1,2,3,4***

This class is taught by certified instructors from Rising Son Mixed Martial Arts. Students will learn self-control and confidence as well as easy verbal and physical techniques to defend themselves. In addition they will learn how to respond to certain situations and that sometimes just diffusing a situation in a calm and confident manner resolves the problems.

***Seasons in the Garden* Thursdays**

Led by: Mr. Ebert of the Monk Botanical Gardens Session 1 & 2 ***Grades K-3***

Come join us to learn how the garden changes during our Wisconsin seasons! Through songs, crafts, and other activities learn about the plants, animals, insects, birds and trees that make a garden special when there is snow on the ground! As our final activity we will take a trip to Monk Gardens to see a real garden in winter and then again in the spring! Come join us.

***Foods around theWorld* Thursdays**

Led By: Ms. Joan from The Neighbors' Place Session 3 ***Grades 2-5***

If you visit another country--What would you eat? What is the favorite food in the other countries? We will be exploring and making foods from around the world as well as explore holiday traditions from other countries.

***Trash Art-Project RecycleArt* Thursdays**

Led By: Ms. Joan from The Neighbors' Place Session 4 ***Grades K-5***

What fun! Upcycling! We will be creating beautiful and creative treasures from recycled trash-recycled jars, cans, and soda bottles. Also we will enjoy working with clay, paints, sand, and chalk.

***Student Leadership Club* Thursdays CONTINUATION OF SESSION 1 AND 2, SAME STUDENTS**

Led by: Ms. Poncek Session 1-4

Here is an opportunity to develop leadership skills by organizing and carrying out school activities and community learning projects. Students involved in this club will be seen as positive role models to peers.

To better serve the needs of our students and families, the format of the afterschool program is as follows:

- We will continue to offer the program right straight through Monday, Tuesday and Thursday for the 3 days between sessions 3 and 4, April 2, 3, and 5, when we will have assemblies and performances. We encourage students to continue to come to these special events as well as the scheduled classes each day, making Semester 2 a continuous program on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays until May 18th.
- All classes are subject to a limited capacity. If there is a need to limit, students meeting the registration deadline will be chosen in a random drawing.
- Students will begin the program at 3:30 ending with dismissal at 4:45. Parent pickup is in the back of school as usual.
- ***Students should indicate on their registration form which classes they are "interested" in . By indicating all their interests, we can then assign students to classes more efficiently. We try to accommodate all requests, but cannot guarantee all students will get all the choices they have indicated. Classes may be canceled if not enough students register for that class. Classes will have capacity limits.***

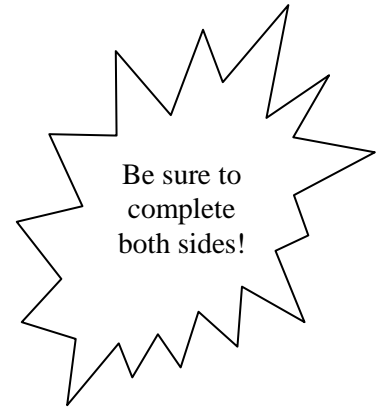
