Self Defense **Thursdays**

Led by Sylvia Thao **Grade K-5 at some point during Sessions 1, 2, 3, 4**

This class is taught by certified instructors from Rising Son Mixed Martial Arts. Students will learn self-control and confidence as well as easy verbal and physical techniques to defend themselves. In addition they will learn how to respond to certain situations and that sometimes just diffusing a situation in a calm and confident manner resolves the problems.

Student Leadership Club (Limited to 12 students) **Thursdays Sessions 1-4**

Led by: Ms. Poncek **Grades 4-5**

Here is an opportunity to develop leadership skills by organizing and carrying out school activities and community learning projects. Students involved in this club will be seen as positive role models to peers and will participate in this club the entire year. As a result, students will be required to not have any discipline referrals.

To better serve the needs of our students and families, the format of the afterschool program will look as follows:

- The after school program classes run straight through Semester 1 every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday we are in school from October 8, 2018-January 17, 2019.
- The **after school program** will break between semesters, January 18 through February 1, 2019.
- Semester 2 after school classes will resume February 4 and run until May 16, 2019. Information on Semester 2 will come home in January.
- We will continue to offer the wonderful enrichment classes as in the past! Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. All classes are subject to a limited capacity and must align with graduation requirements.
- Students will begin the program at 3:30 ending with dismissal at 4:45. Parent pickup is in the back of school as the usual school day.
- ***Students should indicate on their registration form which classes they are "interested" in . By indicating all their interests, we can then assign students to classes more efficiently. We try to accommodate all requests, but cannot guarantee all students will get all the choices they have indicated. Classes may be canceled if not enough students register for that class. Classes will have capacity limits.***

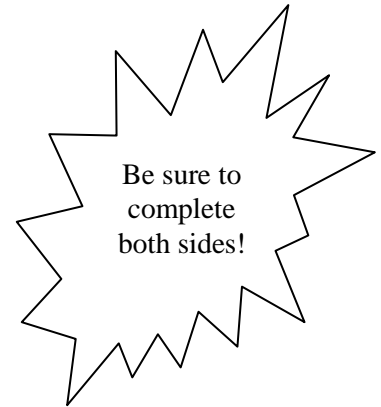
