4K REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 4, 2019

*Registration for the free, half-day 4K Program is a two-step process for all eligible children
(four years of age on or before September 1, 2019)*

STEP 1: ONLINE REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 4, 2019

Please visit <http://wausauschools.org> and click on the 4K Registration tab. Complete and submit the online form. You will receive an electronic confirmation following the completion of Step 1. *The online registration indicates your interest in 4K and preferred site of attendance; however, the paper registration must be completed before your child is fully registered and assigned to a site.* If you do not have computer access, you may register at the 4K & Early Childhood Programs Office at G.D. Jones Elementary School (1018 South 12th Avenue) on or after February 4, 2019, or during a 4K informational meeting. Please contact Sarah Fisher at 715-261-0265 for assistance.

STEP 2: PAPER REGISTRATION BEGINS AFTER COMPLETION OF STEP 1

You will also need to complete a paper registration packet. **Please bring your child's birth certificate if possible.** Please complete the paper registration forms at the 4K & Early Childhood Programs Office at G.D. Jones Elementary School, 1018 South 12th Avenue, Wausau WI 54401 between 8 a.m. - 3 p.m. Completion of these forms will finalize your child's 4K registration.
