Before School Hours of Operation

7:15 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Monday through Friday on days school is in session.
Early Risers: staff members will greet students at the front entrance door from 7:15 to 7:30. All students in Early Risers must be to school by 7:30.

After School Hours of Operation

3:30 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday
Staff is available until 5:00pm for questions/concerns

Please pick up students in the Parent Pick-up area in the back of school.

After school all doors are locked at 3:45. If you need to pick your child up before 4:45 you will need to send a note and/or make prior arrangements.

PLEASE NOTE: Our program will run continuously on every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday school is in session between the dates listed above. We will no longer take a “break” between sessions 1 and 2 in November as in other years. Classes will vary between sessions as listed in this flyer. We will be adding assemblies during the previous “break” time between sessions.

EARLY RISERS 7:15 AM TO 8:30 AM

Grades K-5 / Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday



Students participating in the morning program will meet in the library. Please come prepared to enjoy a great start to your morning. You will have time to finish your homework, or work on your math, spelling, writing, and reading skills. Students may have an opportunity to work with classroom teachers as well as doing projects and through the use of computers, cards, and academic games.

Students must arrive by 7:30 to participate in Early Risers. The doors are locked and no one will be at the doors from 7:30 to 8:15.

Early Risers will run continuously throughout the school year, not in sessions like the after school classes.

LIT BIT 7:30AM TO 8:30AM

This is a teacher recommended program. Students will be notified of placement in this program. Students will be working on literacy under the supervision of a teacher.

3:30 pm	After School Programs <i>Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays</i>	4:45 pm
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These are 3-day per week classes and students are encouraged to attend all 3 days of the week!

CENTRAL STATION

Led by Ms Chastity and Ms. Colleen *Grades K-5 Sessions 1-4*

This program offers an opportunity for fun enrichment activities including crafts, legos, beading, cooking, technology, physical fitness and more.

SELF DEFENSE

Led by Sylvia Thao *Open to Grade K-5 at some point during Sessions 1,2,3,4*

This class is taught by certified instructors from Rising Son Mixed Martial Arts. Students will learn self-control and confidence as well as easy verbal and physical techniques to defend themselves. In addition they will learn how to respond to certain situations and that sometimes just diffusing a situation in a calm and confident manner resolves the problems.

FITASTIC

Led by Ministry Health Staff *Grades K-5 Session 1 and 2*

Food! Fitness! Fun! With a focus on learning lifelong healthy habits, Lincoln students will learn various fitness and wellness activities and taste test healthy and YUMMY recipes.

HMONG FUN

Led by Mrs. Pong Thao *Grades 3-5 Session 1 and 2*

Join this class if you are interested in learning more about the Hmong culture and traditions through reading , songs, arts, crafts, and writing.

YOGA!

Led by: Ms. Jessie Robinson (limit of 15) *Grades 1-5 Session 1 -4*

Kids! Feel like you want to stretch your body, soothe your mind, and get energized? Just say "om" and enjoy an hour of relaxation and fun! Students will also be keeping a yoga diary to take what they learn each week home to share with the family!

SNAPSHOT SCIENCE 3:30 PM TO 4:45 PM

Led by: Mr. Schmidt *Grades 1-2 Session 1 Grades 3-5 Session 2*

Each meeting will feature an important science 'snapshot,' a specific topic or concept which students will explore. Inquiry-based investigations will develop students' natural curiosity and ability to think scientifically, as well as practice science skills such as careful observation, measurement, and use of scientific equipment.

LEGO LAND 3:30 PM TO 4:45 PM

Led by: Mrs. Kramer *Grades K/1/2 Session 1*

Lego's galore! See what you can create with your imagination - combine yours with others to make an object for discussion. How skilled are you at building blindfolded? Whether making patterns or racing against others, come and join us and see where your imagination takes you.

PANDAU

Led by: Ms. Thao *Grades 2-5 Session 1 and 2*

Pandau is a form of textile art that incorporates cross-stitching and embroidery techniques often depicting animals, symbols and/or sceneries. Join Ms. Thao to learn this history telling craft and learn more about the heritage of the Hmong people.

PUPPETS, PUPPETS, PUPPETS

Led By: Joan from The Neighbors' Place *Grades K-1 Session 1*

Come join us as we make finger puppets, sock puppets, glove puppets, stick puppets, and walking puppets! We will use our puppets to act out open-ended situations focusing on diversity and kindness.

FOODS AROUND THE WORLD

Led By: Joan from The Neighbors' Place *Grades 2-5 Session 2*

If you visit Germany--What would you eat? What is the favorite food in the other countries? We will be exploring and making foods from around the world as well as explore holiday traditions from other countries.

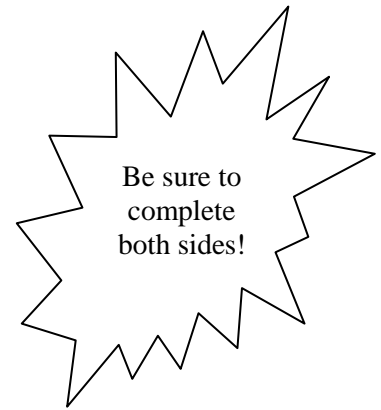
