Before School Hours of Operation

7:15 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Monday through Friday on days school is in session.

Early Risers: staff members will greet students at the front entrance door from 7:15 to 7:30. All students in Early Risers and LitBit must be to school by 7:30.

After School Hours of Operation

3:30 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday

Staff is available until 5:00pm for questions/concerns

Please pick up students in the Parent Pick-up area in the back of school.

After school all doors are locked at 3:40. If you need to pick your child up before 4:45 you will need to send a note and/or make prior arrangements.

PLEASE NOTE: Our program will run continuously on every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday school is in session between the dates listed above. We do not take a “break” between sessions 1 and 2 in November. Classes will vary between sessions as listed in this flyer. We will be adding assemblies or performances during the “break” time between sessions.

Led by Ms. Chastity *Sessions 1 & 2* **Grades K-5**

Homework Help **Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by Mrs. Vang *Sessions 1 & 2* **Grades K-5**

Now is your chance to take time to complete homework and strengthen your abilities in reading, writing, and math. Classroom teachers are available for consultation.

Grins and Giggles Club **Mondays**

Led by Ms. Kirstin McEvoy *Session 1 & 2* **Grades 2-5**

Join us as we read Bedhead, Piggie Pie and other great 'laugh-out-loud' books by Margie Palatini and enjoy creative activities and fun games to go with each book!

Creative Kids in the Kitchen **Mondays**

Led by: Ms. Bovet of Wausau Children's Museum Session 1 & 2 **Grades K-2**

Wausau Children's Museum introduces young students to basic nutrition and food preparation skills through creative, hands-on fun! Students will learn and demonstrate kitchen and food safety skills; prepare delicious, whole-food snacks, and begin to understand the relationship between the foods they prepare and how they affect their health. Emphasis is placed on actively engaging the student through hands-on learning and through art and science activities that complement the week's theme.

Outdoor Sports **Mondays and Thursdays**

Led By: Mrs. Veenstra Session 1 **Grades 3-5**

Come dressed for exploring some outdoor sports such as rollerblading, wiffle ball, kickball and soccer. Weather permitting we will enjoy outdoor sports. If we encounter rainy weather, we will explore a variety of indoor board games.

Into the Outdoors! (*Limited to 15 students*) **Mondays**

Led by: Mr. and Mrs. Burke and Mrs. Veenstra Session 2 **Grades 3-5**

Looking for an adventure!!!! Each meeting students will go outside for fun in the outdoors and learn to use cross country skis and snowshoes (if snow is available) as well as go on hikes and do other winter games!

Play it Safe (*Limited to 10 students*) **Tuesdays**

Led by: The Women's Community Session 1 & 2 **Grade K-2**

In this program students will be involved in fun activities, stories and games fostered around the topic of being safe. Children will learn alternatives to physical and verbal misbehaviors and learn to express themselves positively and assertively. You will also learn protective behaviors, which will motivate children to think critically and follow their instincts. Overall, this program will promote self-esteem and confidence and do so in a fun and friendly way.

Kiddin Around Yoga! **Tuesdays**

Led by: Ms. Jessie Robinson (limit of 15) Session 1 -4 **Grades 1-5**

This is a great way for kids to unwind after a long day in school. Students will practice silly asana sequences, play fun and challenging yoga style games as well as learn self-calming and stress relief techniques to develop strong minds and bodies.

Lego Land **Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by: Ms. Hofmann Session 1 & 2 **Grades 1-4**

Lego's galore! See what you can create with your imagination - combine yours with others to make an object for discussion. How skilled are you at building blindfolded? Whether making patterns or racing against others, come and join us and see where your imagination takes you.

Superkids **Tuesdays and Thursdays**

Led by: Mrs. Giebel Session 1 & 2 **Grade 1**

Join Cass, Hot Rod, Lily and all the other Superkids characters as we support and expand upon the Superkids Reading Program with hands on projects and fun review activities.

Self Defense **Thursdays**

Led by Sylvia Thao Sessions 1-4 **Grade K-5 at some point during Sessions 1, 2, 3, 4**

This class is taught by certified instructors from Rising Son Mixed Martial Arts. Students will learn self-control and confidence as well as easy verbal and physical techniques to defend themselves. In addition they will learn how to respond to certain situations and that sometimes just diffusing a situation in a calm and confident manner resolves the problems.

Wausau Children's Museum **Thursdays**

Led by: Ms. Bovet of Wausau Children's Museum Session 1 & 2 *Grades K-3*

Let's go explore! Students will be bused to the Museum in the Wausau Mall where fun centers await them as well as art prompts for the children to freely explore! See where your imagination will take you! The museum will not be open to the public while students are attending this class.

Cribbage **Thursdays**

Led by: Mrs. Gabriel Session 2 *Grades 3-5*

Do you love the challenge of a fun game! Come and play Cribbage with us! Cribbage is one of the most popular games in the world! This class is for beginners as well as the experienced player.

Student Leadership Club (Limited to 12 students) **Thursdays**

Led by: Ms. Poncek Session 1-4 *Grades 4-5*

Here is an opportunity to develop leadership skills by organizing and carrying out school activities and community learning projects. Students involved in this club will be seen as positive role models to peers. As a result, students will be required to not have any discipline referrals.

To better serve the needs of our students and families, the format of the afterschool program will look as follows:

- The program classes run for 6 weeks each session, and will not take a break between sessions 1 and 2. We will continue to offer the program right straight through every Monday, Tuesday and Thursday for the 5 days between sessions 1 and 2, November 20, 21, 27, 28, 30, when we will have assemblies and performances. We encourage students to continue to come to these special events as well as the scheduled classes each day, making Semester 1 a continuous program on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays
- The program will break between semesters, January 22 through February 2, 2018.
- Semester 2, which is sessions 3 and 4 will resume February 6th and run until May 19, 2018, again no break between sessions 3 and 4. Information on sessions 3 and 4 will come home in January.
- We will continue to offer the wonderful enrichment classes as in the past! Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. All classes are subject to a limited capacity. If there is a need to limit, students meeting the registration deadline will be chosen in a random drawing.
- Students will begin the program at 3:30 ending with dismissal at 4:45. Parent pickup is in the back of school as usual.
- *Students should indicate on their registration form which classes they are "interested" in . By indicating all their interests, we can then assign students to classes more efficiently. We try to accommodate all requests, but cannot guarantee all students will get all the choices they have indicated. Classes may be canceled if not enough students register for that class. Classes will have capacity limits.*

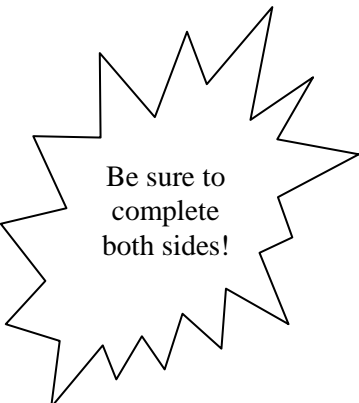
