- * Students are strongly encouraged to have an extra set of clothes to keep in their academic locker. Please see the Student Handbook on the JMMS website for the dress code policy; which is strictly enforced.
- **LOCKER DECORATIONS: In an effort to maintain the new condition of our lockers and ensure their looks and durability for years to come items inside lockers may only be secured with magnets; tape is not allowed. NO CONTACT PAPER allowed due to the sticky residue it leaves.

LOCKER DECORATIONS

In an effort to maintain the new condition of our lockers and ensure their looks and durability for years to come:

- -Nothing is to be taped or attached on the outside of the locker
- -NO CONTACT PAPER is to be used inside the locker! It leaves behind a sticky residue and is very difficult to clean.
- -All items inside the lockers need to be secured with magnets. We kindly ask that you refrain from using any type of tape on inside of the lockers. If tape is used, it must be "painter tape" which can be purchased at most discount or home improvement stores.
- -Items are not to be stored on top of the banks of lockers.

STUDENT DRESS AND APPEARANCE

John Muir takes pride in the appearance of its students. Students' attire reflects the quality of the school, conduct, school work and the general atmosphere of the school. We expect at all times that students will dress and groom themselves appropriately for school. It is expected that such dress will not be disruptive to the learning process. Responsibility for the personal appearance of students enrolled in the Wausau School District shall normally rest with the students themselves and their parents/guardians.

This code is not intended to limit the right of the building and/or district administration to establish rules or restrictions regarding other paraphernalia or dress that disrupts or threatens to disrupt the learning environment of any school. If there is a disagreement between students and/or parents and the staff regarding the appropriateness of clothing or other paraphernalia, the principal, or his/her designee, will use his/her discretion to make the final decision. Student dress or grooming shall not, however:

- a. affect the health or safety of students; or
- b. distract from or disrupt the learning process within the classroom or school setting.

In order to assure a healthy and safe school environment for students, the following student dress code guidelines will be enforced at all times in the school building and on school grounds:

- 1. Appropriate clothing is expected. This includes the following:
- · Skirts, shorts and dresses are not to be excessively short. Mid-thigh length is generally considered appropriate length. If form-fitting pants are worn, a top must be worn to cover the buttocks.
- · Pants that are worn with holes above mid thigh must have leggings worn underneath. Excessively torn and ripped clothing is not to be worn.
- · Muscle shirts, halter tops, low-cut tops exposing cleavage, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, and sheer or see-through clothing are not appropriate. The straps on tank tops must be at least two inches wide and cover all undergarments.
- · Pajamas/sleepwear and anything considered swimwear are not allowed.
- · Bra straps, boxers, or any other type of underwear must not be exposed. This includes exposure due to oversized pants or shorts, regardless of what is worn underneath. Pants and shorts must be worn above the hips.
- 2. During the school day hats, caps, bandannas, head coverings and jackets shall be taken off and placed in the student's locker soon after the student enters the building. These items shall not be worn in the classroom and they shall not be worn in the school building, except when the student has immediately entered the building, is leaving the building, or as part of Spirit Days.
- 3. Medallions or other jewelry which identify gang members or gang affiliation or which have come to represent a gang shall also not be worn or displayed in school or at school events. Also, gang clothing is not always restricted to an item of clothing, but may include the way in which a particular item of clothing is worn. No gang insignia may be worn, possessed, used, distributed, displayed, carried or sold by any student on school grounds or at school-related activities at any time. The reference to "gang insignia" would also encompass items of clothing that signify gang activity by the manners in which they are worn.
- 4. Shoes are to be worn at all times. Slippers and soft bottom footwear are not considered appropriate.
- 5. Wallet chains are not allowed and heavy necklace chains are subject to review by staff.
- 6. Sunglasses are not to be worn except for medical reasons or for designated Spirit Days.
- 7. Students are to properly wear the appropriate safety equipment as required to participate in specific instructional and/or extracurricular activities. This includes but is not limited to: eye protection, goggles, helmets, protective pads, footwear, or anything else deemed necessary by the teacher or by administration.
- 8. No student shall be permitted to wear any clothing that contains pictures, images, and/or writing making reference to:
 - Alcohol, tobacco, sexual content, profanity, gambling, drugs, illlegal activities, violent acts, weapons, gangs, adult establishments,
 - degrading remarks about race/ethnic groups or gender

Students who violate the rules will be subject to the collection of the inappropriate items and/or sent home by the administration for appropriate wearing apparel. A parent conference will be called to return inappropriate items. Repeated violations of school rules may constitute grounds for suspension or other appropriate action to correct the situation.
